
#### 11th Amendment:

States cannot be sued in federal court by one of its citizens, a citizen of another state, or by a foreign country





12th Amendment:

Election of the Pres and VP on separate ballots by the electoral college

(rather than the top two prospects receiving the presidency and vice presidency)








**Civil War Amendments**

16th Amendment: Congress can collect income tax

#### 17th Amendment:

Two Senators from each state are directly elected by the people

Goal: Give people a greater voice



18th Amendment:

Illegal to sell, manufacture, or transport alcoholic beverages

"Prohibition"

21<sup>st</sup> Amendment: Repeals Prohibition







19<sup>th</sup> Amendment: Women's Suffrage



#### 20th Amendment:

"Lame-Duck" Amendment

Pres. takes office Jan 20<sup>th</sup>, new term for Congress begins Jan 3<sup>rd</sup>.





22<sup>nd</sup> Amendment:

Pres. cannot serve more than 2 full terms



### 23<sup>rd</sup> Amendment:

Allows the citizens of the Washington D.C. to vote for Pres and VP

3 presidential electors

(same # as smallest state)



"No taxation without representation!"



24th Amendment:

Prohibits the use of poll taxes in federal elections





25<sup>th</sup> Amendment:

If the Pres dies or cannot lead, VP takes office

If VP dies or resigns, the Pres cannot appoint a replacement





26th Amendment:

No one over the age of 18 can be denied the right to vote by virtue of age





### 27th Amendment:

Any pay raise
Congress gives it's
members does not
take effect until a
new election has
taken place.

Proposed in 1789, passed in 1992
