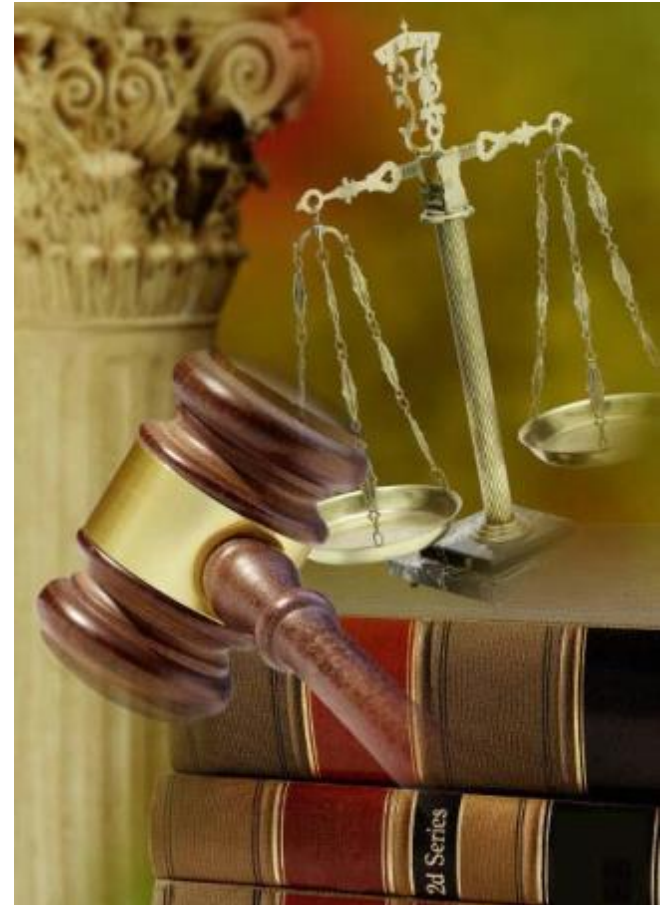


PAGE 20 – EXTENDING THE BILL OF RIGHTS

11th Amendment:

States cannot be sued in federal court by one of its citizens, a citizen of another state, or by a foreign country

12th Amendment:

**Election of the Pres and VP on separate
ballots by the electoral college**

*(rather than the top two prospects receiving the
presidency and vice presidency)*

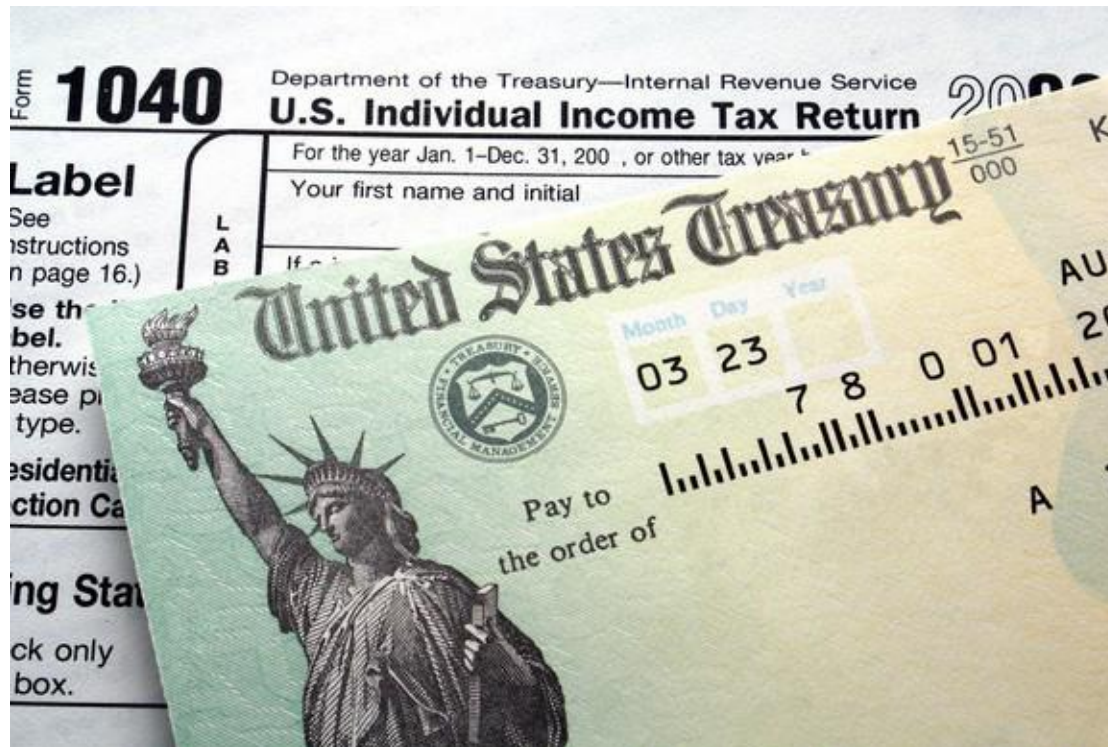
Civil War Amendments

17th Amendment:

Two Senators from each state are directly elected by the people

Goal: Give people a greater voice

18th Amendment:

**Illegal to sell,
manufacture, or
transport alcoholic
beverages**

“Prohibition”

21st Amendment:

Repeals Prohibition

20th Amendment:

“Lame-Duck” Amendment

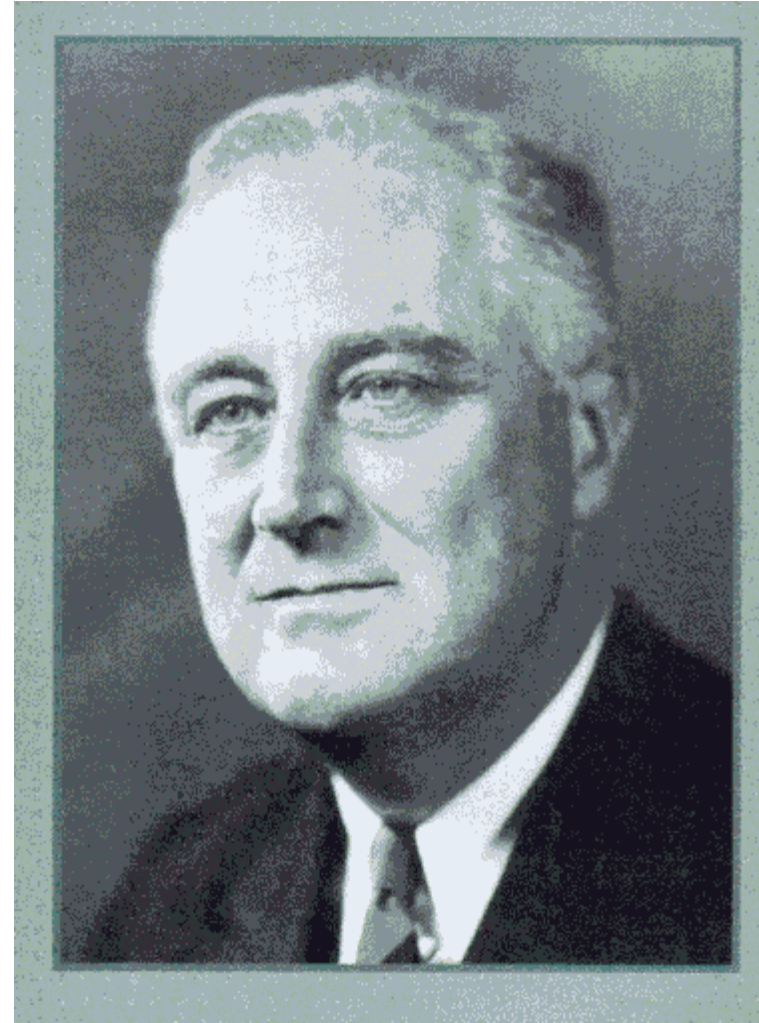
**Pres. takes office Jan 20th,
new term for Congress
begins Jan 3rd.**

22nd Amendment:

**Pres. cannot serve
more than 2 full
terms**



PAGE 20 – EXTENDING THE BILL OF RIGHTS

23rd Amendment:

Allows the citizens
of the Washington
D.C. to vote for
Pres and VP

3 presidential
electors

(same # as smallest
state)



“No taxation without representation!”



PAGE 20 – EXTENDING THE BILL OF RIGHTS

24th Amendment:

**Prohibits the use
of poll taxes in
federal elections**

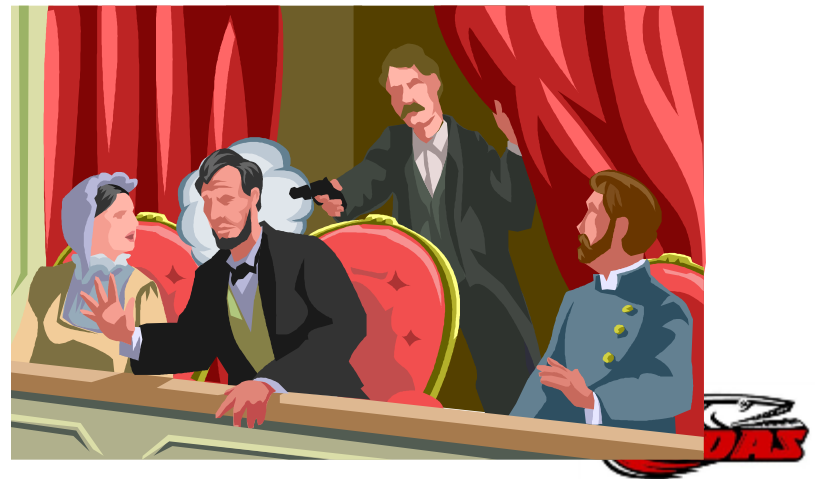


PAGE 20 – EXTENDING THE BILL OF RIGHTS

25th Amendment:

If the Pres dies or cannot lead, VP takes office

If VP dies or resigns, the Pres cannot appoint a replacement



PAGE 20 – EXTENDING THE BILL OF RIGHTS

26th Amendment:

No one over the age of 18 can be denied the right to vote by virtue of age



PAGE 20 – EXTENDING THE BILL OF RIGHTS

27th Amendment:

Any pay raise Congress gives it's members does not take effect until a new election has taken place.

Proposed in 1789,
passed in 1992
